

Psychiatric Clinic Zugersee, CH-6317 Oberwil bei Zug

The Psychiatric Clinic (PC) Zugersee, a centre for Psychiatry and Psychotherapy –known until 2007 as Oberwil Clinic, Franciscan Centre— is of rare origin. In 1909 the Capuchin Father, Rufin Steimer, founded the "Franciscan Sanatorium ". Then, from 1923, the community of the "Brothers of Mercy of Our Lady of Perpetual Help", a nursing order, took over the centre. Until the eighties of the last century, the Brothers of Mercy run this sanatorium as a psychiatric clinic. The order still supports today's PC Zugersee. The institution is located in an incomparably beautiful hillside overlooking the Lake Zug and it currently has more than 133 beds.

After an intensive investigation work, they decided that the laundry requirements were no longer met and that laundry was to be treated in house.
